
The Live Release Rate












2013 Animal Care Statistics



The Foster Care Program is one of the many life saving arms of ACCT Philly. The primary reason for foster care is to provide a temporary home for a potentially adoptable animal whose current condition is not manageable in a shelter setting and to alleviate overcrowding.
